COVID-19 Monitoring Criteria – June 2020

Criteria

For Kutsinhira to hold in-person, outdoor classes, Kutsinhira must meet all state and local government requirements and pass the following two criteria:

1) Lane County must maintain green or yellow risk level according to the Harvard Global Health Institute map. <https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>.

Meeting these risk levels means there are less than 10 new daily cases per 100k people on a 7-day moving average. The risk level color coding is explained here: https://globalepidemics.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/06/TTSI_general_briefing_v3-1.pdf

2) Lane County must meet 3 out of 6 applicable metrics as reported by the Oregon Health Authority

From the website: "The OHA is monitoring six indicators that measure the health burden of COVID-19 in each Oregon county and the capacity of the county to respond. Together, these are the health signs we consider when we make recommendations about counties reopening or stopping, watching, and redirecting. Although these indicators overlap with some of the Governor's Reopening Criteria, they are only one part of that larger framework."

- 1) % ED visits for COVID-like illness (should be below 1.5%)
- 2) Trend in percent of tests that are positive in last 7 days (should not trend up)
- 3) Percent increase in new cases in last 7 days (should be no more than 5%)
- 4) Percent of cases not traced to a known source in last 7 days (should be below 30%)
- 5) Trend in COVID-19 hospitalizations over the last 14 days (should downtrend)
- 6) Percent of cases in last 7 days with follow up within 24 hours (should be 95% or more)

Monitoring

Two designated Kutsinhira board members or staff will check these sites once every day. A failure on both sites will be communicated to the Kutsinhira board for further deliberation regarding a closure.
